

## Chemical Card Training Expression of Interest

Rural Lands Protection Board's have contacted us regarding a requirement for their staff to sight the current chemical accreditation card/certificate for any person picking up 1080 baits.

NSW Farmers' Association Chemical Card training gives the required accreditation and is available to our members and non members. We would be very happy to offer Chemical Card training for your district, particularly as a combined activity with your RLPB.

Our training has been designed for farmers, although it is suitable for anyone seeking accreditation. It is at AQF3 level, the recommended level for people who work with chemicals unsupervised. Participants receive a Statement of Attainment in 3 competencies and a plastic card showing name, certificate number and competencies, and expiry date.

Chemical Card training is offered in mixed mode - home study plus workshop attendance. This means that farmers spend less time away from the farm than with other providers. Initial training requires 1 day workshop attendance and refresher training requires 1/2 day attendance.

We now offer both, initial and refresher workshops fully online, so participants are able to complete all training at home. Please contact us if you wish to enrol in an online workshop.

We welcome both members and non members to our training.
